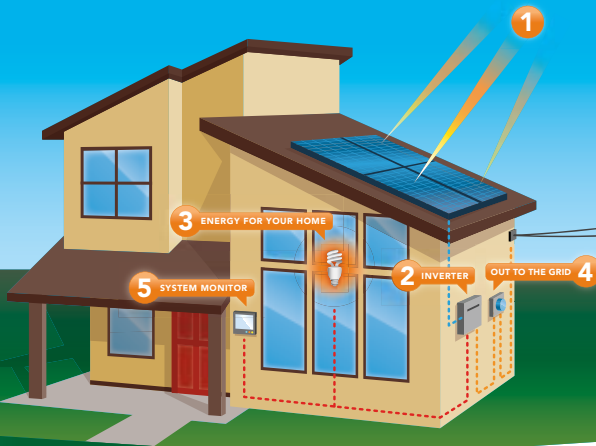
Federal Tax Credit

Example: 2,070 W (DC) PV System in PGE Territory

\$15,525	Installed price
<u>-\$3,623</u>	ETO Incentive
\$11,902	Net Out-of-pocket
-\$6,000	Oregon RETC
<u>-\$3,571</u>	Fed. tax credit
\$2,331	Final Cost*





How does it work?

1. The sun's radiation is converted to DC electricity
2. The inverter converts the DC to AC power for use in your home
3. If your home needs electricity, it will use the solar power, when available—**saving you money**
4. If you are generating extra electricity, it is sent to the power grid for a credit on your power bill—**saving you money**
5. The system monitor tells you how much electricity your solar is generating, and how much electricity you're using—**to help you save money**
- 6. Simple, right?**

The system example on the front will save you nearly \$250 in electricity in its first year! Savings will grow as energy rates inflate.
